Subject :- Re-Opening of Nursing & Paramedical Institutions

CIRCULAR

It is hereby notified for information of all the Principals of Nursing & Paramedical Institutions that the Institutions shall reopen for offline classes w.e.f 16th of August 2021. The concerned Nursing & Paramedical students shall attend to their offline classes as per the programme already devised by the concerned institutions. The concerned faculty as well as students shall ensure strict implementation of the directions issued by the U.T of J&K from time to time and while reopening the offline classes they must ensure to observe all the SOP's / Guidelines with respect to prevention of spread of epidemic ie.

All safety measures including social distancing, personal hygiene, wearing of masks and sanitization to be strictly followed.

- 1. All the students must have got both the jabs of COVID Vaccination and they will be required to provide a certificate to this effect in their respective institutes.
- 2. They shall avoid the risk of transmission, the students, faculty and staff should be screened and symptomatic ones be advised to get clinically assessed before allowing them entry into the classes. In this regard adequate arrangements of thermal scanners, sanitizers and face masks should be made available at all entry and exit points including the reception area.
- **3.** All the students and other staff should wear masks compulsory and have their own sanitizer also with them.
- **4.** The minimum distance between two students shall be maintained as per the standing SOP's / guidelines i.e at least two meters apart from each other.

- 5. While coming and leaving the college the students and staff should maintain physical distance of at least two meters from each other and no student or staff member should breach this rule either during the class work or while coming or leaving the institute. In all cases gathering or grouping should be avoided and everybody should come and leave college individually.
- **6.** All other SOP's / Guidelines issued by Ministry of Health and Family Government of India and Department of Health and Medical Education Department, J&K from time to time are to be implemented scrupulously.
